





GROUND RULES

The objective of this association shall be to promote good fellowship and to provide recreation among and for horse-lovers, young and old.

1. Any rider/driver under 18 or entered in a youth class is required to wear a helmet while mounted or in a cart on the grounds.
2. A current negative coggins test and rabies vaccine will be required within one year of date.
3. Cantering outside of fenced in rings is not allowed, except as required by special events.
4. Horses are not allowed in designated spectator areas.
5. Horses and horse trailers must be at least 200 feet away from concession stand.
6. When trail riding, use path around outside area of hay field.
7. Riding boots or shoes with heels are required. Sneakers or flat soled shoes are not allowed.
8. Use of alcoholic beverages on the grounds by participants, handlers, judges, officials, committee members and spectators during any active horse-related event is strictly prohibited.
9. Riding double is not allowed, except as required by special events.
10. All riders ride at their own risk and are responsible for damage done by their horse.
11. Abuse of horses will not be tolerated, riders will be asked to leave and will receive no refund. If you have concerns about the treatment of any horse, please address it with a committee member.
12. At the discretion of committee members, anyone whose horse cannot be controlled in or out of the ring and may cause injury will be asked to leave without any refund.
13. All dogs must be leashed, attended at all times and kept away from all riding rings or you will be asked to remove your dog from the grounds. If your dog barks excessively, please leave them at home.
14. This is a family focused club, foul language or excessive cursing is strongly discouraged. If any person has an issue with any other member during an event, notify a committee member as soon as possible so that it can be addressed in a timely manner.
15. **Use of club grounds, other than events, is for members only.**
16. Please return equipment to designated area after use.
17. Horses are not to be turned loose in the Sand Ring, Grass Ring or Trail Ring and lunging is not allowed in the Grass Ring.
18. Persons participating in an ongoing event have priority use of all rings and the grounds over all other riders or persons on the grounds.
19. Persons who are not in good standing with the club are not eligible for year end awards.

Per the NWRDC By-Laws the event committee has the ability to prohibit further participation at any event in any form by participants, judges, officials, committee members and spectators due to inappropriate conduct and request immediate removal from the grounds if deemed necessary. The Board of Directors maintains the right to suspend any member due to inappropriate conduct at meetings, trail rides, shows, races, or other activities, without refund of dues.

Please be aware that the individual events being held at NWRDC have their own rules that need to be followed, for a list of those rules please contact the individual committees.

NWRDC Age Requirements Per Division

Adult-19 & over, Senior-14 to 18, **Junior-5 to 13, Advanced Beginner-5 to 18, Beginner-5 to 18, New Beginner-5 to 18, Lead Line 10 and under**, Mini/VSE(very small equine) open, Green Horse-14 & over, Novice/Green Rider-14 & over (No stallions)

All stallions and stud colts to be handled by 19 & over

NWRDC Horse Show Guidelines

- For Horse show purposes, the age of an individual on January 1st shall be maintained throughout the show year. Horses will be (1 year old) 1st of January following date of birth.
- Show committee reserves the right to move an individual up to the next division based on their riding ability. Mandatory to follow rules of division or move up.

A Beginner, New Beginner, Novice Green Rider, Green Horse should never have shown at the canter/lope or hand gallop in a horse show, gymkhana or other horse related event that was timed or judged. Classes to consist of walk and trot/jog only. Beginners, New Beginners, Novice Green Rider, Green Horse should not canter on the grounds at any equine event or they will be moved up to a higher division.

Any rider 18 years of age and under must wear approved headgear when mounted or in a driving cart. Approved headgear consists of sport helmets, hunt seat hard hats or western hard hats. HELMETS are to be fastened.

Attire of exhibitors in general is to be neat, clean, workmanlike and SAFE; NO tennis shoes allowed. Appropriate attire does not include t-shirts, tank tops, shorts, etc.

Western riders are expected to wear a long sleeved shirt, appropriate pants, cowboy boots and a western hat or helmet. Chaps are **NOT** allowed for western fitting and showmanship or model western, but are optional for all other western classes.

English riders should wear approved headgear, jodhpurs/breeches, paddock/tall boots and coat.

The NWRDC, Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury to horse, rider or spectator; or for the loss or theft of personal property or equipment.

Water, restrooms, concession stand and emergency first-aid supplies are located on the grounds.

At the discretion of the judge and show committee any horse appearing not to be sound will be asked to leave the ring.

NWRDC HORSE SHOW CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Fitting & Showmanship: To be judged on showmanship with horse or pony in hand, as well as grooming and condition of horse or pony, both standing and at the walk and trot on the line. Pattern will be handed out. DQ for being off pattern.

Championship Fitting & Showmanship: To be judged to the same standards as the Fitting & Showmanship Class with a championship and reserve championship ribbon presented to the top two placing entries in each class. (14 & older, 13 & under) 1st through 6th place will get points towards day end and year end. Anyone can enter, no qualification needed.

Equitation: Only the rider is being judged. To be judged on hands, seat and position and ability to control the horse at the walk, trot/jog and canter/lope (NEBG, BEG, NGR, GH, do not canter/lope). Juniors, Seniors, Advanced Beginners & Adults may be asked to drop stirrups at the walk and trot/jog only.

Pleasure Class: To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring. Entries may be asked to extend the trot or jog. Animals must stand quietly and back readily. Manners and leads to count heavily. (New Beginners, Beginners, Novice Green Rider, Green Horse do not canter/lope).

Championship Pleasure Class: To be judged to the same standards as the Pleasure Class with a championship and reserve championship ribbon presented to the top two placing entries in each class. There will be a walk/trot class and a walk/trot/canter class. 1st through 6th place will get points towards high point day end and high point year end. Anyone can enter, no qualification needed.

Model Horse English Open or Model Horse Western Open

To be judged in a bridle (English)/halter (Western) on conformation (standing) and at the walk and trot/jog on the line for the breed and seat. English horses 2 years and under may be shown in suitable halter.

Road Hack (English/Western): To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot/jog, road trot, canter/lope and hand gallop with the ability to move on if required. Excessive speed at the hand gallop shall be penalized. No more than (6) horses will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To stand quietly and back readily. Martingales are not permitted. Must be able to change from any gait to a flat footed walk at judge's command. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability for a road hack, and conformation. Green horse, novice/green rider, beginners do not canter/lope or hand gallop.

Trail Class: To be judged over obstacles in the trail ring. Pattern & trail rules will be handed out. Rider must go on to the next obstacle after 3 refusals or you will be disqualified. Excessive discipline will not be tolerated, rider **will** be disqualified. No practice is allowed on course prior to competing. Competitor is responsible to notify the Judge of class name or number they are competing in prior to the start of the class.

New Beginner: 5 to 18, walk & trot/jog only, riders may use two hands with any seat. Attendants are allowed in the ring, on the center grass. Attendants must be **14** years of age or older. Judging will be at Judge's discretion based on the amount of verbal and physical assistance the rider receives. 2 year limit in this division. New Beginners are only allowed in their division classes and the in hand trail class.

In Hand Trail Open: To be shown in a suitable halter with lead, chain optional, any other equipment will be cause for disqualification. No points to be taken off for saddle being on the horse during class. (This class is now eligible for year end award!) No lunge lines. To be judged over obstacles in the trail ring. Handler must move on to the next obstacle after 3 refusals or you will be disqualified. Open to any exhibitor from any division.

NWRDC Pleasure Class

Free to members of the NWRDC in good standing only. Both exhibitor and equine to be judged. Open to all seats. To be shown at the walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring (Beg., NGR, GH & Advanced **Beginner** do not canter/lope). At the judges command shown at any gait on a light rein. To be judged on manners and performance. Correct leads to count. This class will now count towards high point day end and high point year end.

Novice/Green Rider

This class is for riders 14 years of age and older, who are novice/green riders, or riders who choose not to canter or lope anymore. No stallions. Walk and trot/jog only. Riders should not canter/lope on the grounds during any judged or timed event or they will be moved up to a higher division. With the exception of Mini/VSE, riders may not cross enter any other division. Two hands may be used with any bit with any age horse.

Advanced Beginner 5 to 18, admittance into this division is the 1st year competing at the canter/lope and can compete for 1 year in this division. Limited canter/lope at judge's discretion.

Mini/VSE 40 inches and under Division

Open to any equine 40 inches and under. Exhibitor may enter any other open class with the exception of Open Pleasure Driving.

Mini/VSE 40" and under – Hunter Over Fences

To be judged on equine's performance over fences, not to be timed. Hunters are to be judged on style, manners and way of going, with preference given to those horses that cover the course at an even pace, with free flowing strides, as in a brisk trot or canter. Handlers are allowed to go over the jump with the horse but will be penalized if they make contact or knock over jump.

Mini/VSE Pleasure Driving

Drivers should strive to present an appropriate turnout for the vehicle and way of going of the horse. Whip must be in driver's hand. To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk, pleasure trot, and road trot. Judged on performance and manners. Headers are permitted.

Mini/VSE Obstacle Driving

Drivers will negotiate a course of 5-8 obstacles. Judged on performance, way of going, manners, responsiveness and willingness. Drivers will have a maximum of 60 seconds per obstacle. Refusals will be penalized, off-course is elimination.

Open Pleasure Driving

To be shown at a walk, trot, and road trot both ways of the ring. No sulkies allowed. Blinders are optional. Easy ground covering action is desired. Manners, suitability and a quiet responsive mouth are paramount. Exhibitors are to dress neatly and conservatively. Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Headers are permitted. Will count towards day end and year end high point. Open to any driving horses of any size.

Green Horse

This class is for riders 14 and over and horses 2 years and over. Horses may not compete in this division as "green" if they have competed in a canter/lope division in the past or any other division except "green". A horse designated as "green" may not cross over into other divisions. A green horse cannot canter/lope in or out of the ring at any event. Horses may compete for 2 years only, (regardless of number of shows competed in any season). Two hands may be used with any bit with any age horse.

Lead Line Equitation/Pleasure/Trail

Children 10 and under, whom have never shown off lead in a horse show, gymkhana or other related competition that was judged or timed. To be shown at a walk and may be asked to trot or jog a little bit. Equitation class judged on ability to maintain seat and position and exercise some degree of control. Pleasure class to be judged on horse's manners and responsiveness to rider at the walk and may be asked to trot or jog. May enter open in hand trail. Children are allowed to wear chaps. For Year End Division Champion/Reserve Champion, participants must enter all 3 lead line classes at 4 shows.

Note: There will be no tapaderos, hackamores, bit-less bridles, side pulls or nose bands on western bridles allowed. There will be no martingales allowed in flat classes. Two-handed riding in western only allowed in the new beginner, green horse, novice green rider divisions or in other classes if the horse is five years of age or under and in a shankless snaffle bit or bosal. Proof of horse's age must be through registration or a letter from a certified veterinarian. Hoof boots are allowed but no bell boots, leg splint boots or other leg protection coverings allowed. Horses shown western must present all western tack & horses shown english must present all english tack, violator will be DQ from class.

A separate warm-up ring is provided for warm-up. This is the only place that warm-up will be allowed, not in the parking area, on the track or the hay field. **(CANTERING OTHER THAN IN THE SHOW RING OR WARM-UP RING IS PROHIBITED)**. This is for the protection of children and spectators. Driving horses may warm up on the track.

Shows will be held rain or shine: however, if extreme weather conditions raise any doubt (if it is thought the grounds may be so wet as to be unsafe) please contact the horse show contact person on page one (names listed) for verification.

There will be a \$1.00 non-refundable charge for numbers. **Unwanted numbers can be returned to the show booth.** Fees will be **\$9.00** per class for members and **\$11.00** per class for non-members. Post entry fee is \$3.00 per class. There will be a **\$5.00** per rider maintenance fee for all riders. **Entry fees required with all pre-registration entries and are non-refundable. Post entry fees apply to all classes added the day of the show. Check or Cash Only!**

A current negative coggins test and rabies vaccination will be required. A copy must be attached to your pre-entry form in order to be considered pre-entered. Copy will be kept on file for the season. You will not be able to show if your paper work is not complete. Coggins paper work & presented equine will be randomly spot checked throughout the show year. The management suggests and recommends that all horses be up to health standards.

In Beginner, Junior, Senior, Advanced Beginner and Adult Western classes, only one hand is to be used for reining unless the horse is five years of age or under and in a shankless snaffle bit **or bosal.**

All riders are expected to be on deck when called. They must be in the ring by third call or they will be disqualified. If you are having problems, or need a hold, please notify the people in the booth.

Correct exhibitor number must be properly displayed upon entering the ring for judging or entry will be disqualified.

If someone has any issues with the judge or how the show is being run, they must follow the following procedure.

First you must bring your comments or concerns to an open show committee member who will then bring it to the judge at the end of the show or at a time convenient for the judge. No person can approach the Judge directly in or out of the ring. If a person violates this rule, the exhibitor or the exhibitor associated with said person will forfeit all points earned for the day and will be banned from showing in the remaining classes that day and no refund will be given.

If the judge observes coaching from the sidelines during a class, exhibitor may be docked points.

Please help us enjoy our grounds by cleaning up any trash or litter in your area before you leave. **Please spread any hay or manure out so that the lawn is easier to mow.**

The club grounds are located on Rte 104 in North Fairfax, VT, near the reservoir. For persons using GPS, the street address is **2731 Main Street, Fairfax, VT.** Take exit 19 off I-89, turn left and go three miles on Rte 104. Please be sure to use only the club driveway rather than the **MANE ATTRACTION STABLES DRIVEWAY, WHICH IS PRIVATE PROPERTY.**

Please park excess vehicles in designated area.

Year End Awards

In order to qualify for year end ribbons or awards, you must attend four horse shows out of the five that we hold with the same horse and same rider, with the exception of lead line that can use a different horse.

For year end division awards, you must enter all 4 division classes at each show.

We offer all divisions champion and reserve champion as well as Championship Fitting & Showmanship, Model Western, Model English, Mini/VSE Driving, In Hand Trail and Lead Line champion and reserves.

Mini/VSE Pleasure Driving and Mini/VSE Obstacle Driving are to be combined for year end ribbons and awards and **exhibitors must enter both driving classes at each show.** Lead Line Equitation, Lead Line Pleasure and Lead Line Trail to be combined for year end ribbons and awards.

We also have a participation award or ribbon for those lead liners, who go to four of our five shows **and enter all three lead line division classes.**

Basic Guidelines for Emergencies

Notify a committee member immediately

A committee member is responsible for calling 911.

Further assistance from anyone with medical experience will be requested if necessary.

First aid supplies are available at each booth.

Ensure the safety of the horse and or the person involved

Horse

Do not chase the horse, once calmed, attempt to approach it

Close or block all gates and passage areas when possible

Rider

Assess the persons injuries (avoid movement especially if the injury is to the head, neck or back). Keep the person as calm and comfortable as possible (for example blankets, shade, water, etc.) Keep the number of persons around the injured party to minimum.
